Prepare for the Honor

NJHS at Platteview Central is for 8th-grade students. Students in the 7th-grade can begin the application process in late March. Students must have a **3.7 GPA or higher** at the end of semester one in their 7th grade year and a 3.7 GPA or higher during the first half of semester two. Applicants must provide examples of how they demonstrate the 5 pillars of NJHS. The induction ceremony is held in early May.
